**Secretary's Report:**

There was a reading of minutes. Mike Frontz, motioned to approve. Lori Johnson seconded the motion. Minutes were approved unanimously.

Charito passed out the photo release for the Boosters' website to parents attending the meeting and informed that the releases would be distributed to all students to give to remaining parents after the meeting.

Charito asked parent to give opinions of the new website. The general consensus was that the website is doing well.

**Vice President:**

Dave was not present. Mike shared on his behalf that he wants to reiterate that when you sign up for a volunteer position that it doesn't mean you have to do it every week. Picnic is scheduled for August 11. All families are asked to bring a hot item and a dessert or side.

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**Director's Report:**

Mike shared on the directors behalf that the progress of the show going slower than last year due to having 44 new members. It appears that about 20 bands have signed up for the invitational. Mike reminded that an invitation coordinator will be needed in 2 year. The estimated ending time of performance should be around 9:00 PM. There was talk of awards donations. The invitational coordinator was not present and the conversation was tabled.

**President's Report:**

The band trip got confirmation on the date. The band will leave on Jan 5, a Friday, and return Sunday night. The Friday will be an excused absences. The cost is \$244 per student. The Boosters is looking for chaperones and nurses. It is estimated that about 25 chaperones will be needed. Chaperones get the student price. It is also estimated that about 11 male chaperones will be needed. Chaperones have to be overnight status approved by the school district. Mike reviewed clearance requirements. FBI clearances must be through Department of Education. Chaperone needs will be announced at picnic. Commitment forms and \$25 deposit per person are due by September 7. It was predicated that by the end of October after the fundraisers, the treasurer will let parent know what remaining funds are needed to cover the trip. On October 24, \$125 per person will be requested. On November 17 the remainder is due. A hand out on trip details was given to parents present.

**New Business:**

Pit is going to come up with an alternative uniform as there are not enough for every student due to the band's growth. Mr. Brackbill and administration will decide on a plan for uniforms for next school year.

It was determined that 2 trailers will be needed for instrument transportation.
